

## Stoma Appliances prescribing policy statement

### Fair Usage policy

- New products should only be initiated by the commissioned specialist stoma nurses. Prospective requests for new items from companies should be ignored
- Do not issue retrospective prescriptions for stoma products
- Flushable bags should only be initiated by the commissioned stoma nurses and should account for no more than 30% of total bags prescribed
- Requests for repeats should be raised by the patient

### When prescribing please remember

- Quantities stated are a recommendation for average usage. Patient's requirements are on an individual needs basis. Rare cases of larger quantities (usually short term) will be under the advice of the specialist Stoma nurses.
